Report from Share Register

On 31 December 2022, the Share Register comprised 14,946 shares totalling £74,730, a net increase over the year of 414 shares worth £2,070 to the Society. In addition, there are 594 shares worth £2,970 which have been converted to loan capital as there are 127 shareholdings of less than 10 shares.

During the course of the year, as Share Registrar, I liaised with SIGBI to identify shareholders who were no longer Soroptimists. Each received a letter reminding them that they cannot hold shares if they are no longer Soroptimists.

Some shareholders, for various reasons, chose to transfer their shares to their Clubs, regions or other Soroptimists. I have therefore effected 4 transfers totalling 169 shares during the course of the year.

In addition, I have dealt with any email queries received from members; I have prepared a report for each Board meeting and then followed up on any actions required.

Much time has been spent liaising with the Executors of deceased Members. Members are reminded that there is a simple nomination form which can be completed and attached to the Share Certificates which would allow them to leave their shares to their Club, Region or Federation. Please also encourage other Soroptimists or your Clubs to support the Society by purchasing shares – perhaps your Friendship Link Clubs might be interested? A minimum of 10 shares allows you to vote: there are currently 90 individual shareholders and 37 Clubs/Regions who do not hold the minimum number.
